

BLOOMFIELD ORCHARDS SUBDIVISION NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

The **Footing Drain Disconnection Project** is continuing throughout the year in the Bloomfield Orchards Subdivision. Approximately 265 homes (or 50% of all homes) will have sump pumps installed and the footing drains disconnected by the end of March 2002. However, every home in the subdivision must be disconnected to eliminate basement flooding in the subdivision. The City of Auburn Hills is continuing to fund all work at this time relative to footing drain disconnects and is requesting additional volunteers for the program. An Information Sheet is attached if you desire to take advantage of this City funded program. Upcoming Construction Activities

Temporary road closures may occur throughout the Bloomfield Orchards Subdivision this summer and fall as construction continues toward the overall goal of improving the storm sewer, sanitary sewer and water main in the subdivision.

Sanitary sewer and water main construction projects on Sheffield Road will be completed in 2002 with road closures between Hamlet and Hempstead. Every effort will be made to maintain access to homes in the affected areas at all times, but your patience is greatly appreciated as these improvements occur. The projects will continue in April or May and will be completed by July of 2002. Based on the nature of these projects, temporary detours will be required to maintain access to homes in the subdivision. The City of Auburn Hills requests that residents make every attempt to follow the detours as posted and to proceed through all construction areas with caution.

In addition, the water main on Hamlet from Liverpool to Hempstead and along Liverpool will be replaced during the summer months. Traffic will be maintained through these areas except during occasional brief periods.
